


#### **CON**


- I think repeating in 2025 is better than 2024

- and start delirium awarness projects
- It is the best delirium awareness way
  - I think 2025 is a best option. Can give us time to publish papers. Its important to have publications, so our colleagues will participate with more enthusiasm and we can reflect better in the survey and how to perform.
  - My opinion: Maybe each representative or each hospital/clinic will do an awareness project and then repeat the study, but we should not wait years.

#### Delirium letter-a-thon.

Write a letter to your local Member of Parliament about delirium. Send a copy to your national organisation and the best letter (or best three letters) wins a prize

#### **Delirium research fundraising:**

run a delirium research fundraising activity. The group that raises the most funds in each country wins a prize

#### Delirium carer sign-up.

Set up a delirium carer support organisation in your country or internationally with a website with resources and organise educational/ support group meetings. Recruit carers to the organisation (no fee). The country or group that signs up the most members wins a prize

#### Delirium front-line workers awards.

Call for nominees for best front-line nurse/allied health/junior doctor who "fight" delirium. National awards. Have a presentation ceremony on WDAD

### Consensus

Thank you all for this intense and excellent discussion. The main consensus is ...

We want to keep people together: We created a large research network, and we need to give participants some input and feedback, so that they feel connected, and feel supported.

**WDAD Survey**: we will not repeat the WDAD point prevalence study in 2024. It is too early, participants did not get feedback of results, and might be tired of too many surveys.

**Delirium Awareness Projects**: instead of repeating the survey in 2024, we will perform awareness-projects on World Delirium Awareness Day on March 13<sup>th</sup> 2024. The group around Chris Gabor (<a href="www.deliriumday.com">www.deliriumday.com</a>) will develop some ideas. We will inform all of you about the progress.

**WDAD Survey for first-time-participants**: Countries which missed participation in 2023, can perform the survey in 2024 (e.g. Brazil, Singapore, Philippines, and others). If so, please let me know and send me an email.

**Feedback**: participants want to know some results, and maybe want to compare themselves to others. We will make a draft with a new graphic and report some results. Before sharing it with all participants, we will share it with you, and it might be translated into other languages...

**Survey**: we might perform a small survey with participants about the impact of joining the last survey: how did it influenced awareness for delirium?
